Sadaqat-ul-fitr \$8 per person to be paid before Salatul'Eid. Zakat-ul-fitr should be paid by adult Muslim, with sufficient food for the family for a day, for himself/herself and all his/her dependents including a newborn child. Zakat al-Fitr should preferably be paid early enough so it will reach the needy and the poor before the Eid day. It will enable them to use it for food and clothes and give them the opportunity to enjoy the happiness of Eid-ul-Fitr.
